

Multiple Jurisdictions Impacted


Multiple Levels of Jurisdictions Involved






Jurisdictional Complexity Profile of 2018 Fire Year Multiple Jurisdictions Impacted




Jurisdictional Complexity Profile of 2018 Fire Year **Multiple Levels of Jurisdictions Involved**




Jurisdictional Complexity Profile of 2018 Fire Year Fire Organization: Use of Unified Command



Of the fire organizations that went into UC, 64% involved BOTH federal and state actors

Big Take Aways

- In 2018, Type 1 and 2 fires routinely had 3 to 4 jurisdictions impacted representing 3 levels of government
- None of the current complexity analysis includes representation of private interests which is a whole additional layer of complexity
- Improving fire management will require improving our ability to govern large multi-jurisdictional fire organizations... but what does that mean?
