This workshop is designed to train landowners on how to burn their forest land with a special emphasis on burning longleaf pine. The format consists of classroom and field experience where you will be the part of a burn team and will get actual experience burning a tract of forest land. Topics to be covered include: How to Plan a Burn, Smoke Management, Liability, Burning Techniques, Equipment, Cost Share Assistance and Safety. Participants are asked to wear field clothes made from natural fibers such as cotton and leather boots.

Do not wear synthetic fiber clothing.
